The City of Delray Beach has wrapped up the first phase of Community Workshop Meetings.

We are now entering the writing portion of the Comprehensive Planning process. We are currently working on the following elements:

This will include Capital Improvement, Future Land Use, Public Facilities, and Intergovernmental Coordination.
