- 3.) Linton Boulevard, I-95 to SW 10th Avenue

Are these roadways over capacity today? What do you want to see, and how do you want the City to get there?

-We have 7 active community gardens in the City. Do you know about them? Do any of our community gardens need improvement? If so, how? What programs would you like to see to get the community more involved in these gardens?
